Prime Lambs

A smaller than expected show was forward with trade again firmer than the previous week.

Medium Lambs 38-44kg averaged 152ppkg.

Lambs were still hard to sell mainly due to there being too many about. Heavy lambs averaged 125ppkg.

Cast Ewes

Only 250 ewes were forward with the trade very similar to that seen the previous week.

Mule ewes averaged £61 and Swale ewes averaged £38.

Prime Cattle

The largest show of the year with over 30 head of prime cattle and OTM cows forward.

Top price OTM went to Alan Myerscough with a 750kg Limousin cow making 140ppkg and purchased by D Barker.

Store Cattle

Over 200 head were sold with trade up on that seen a fortnight ago.

Top price of £1160 was achieved by a pen of 3 red steers, 20 months old sold by Wearing Bros, Low Shaw, and purchased by D Barker, Scarborough.

Also from Messrs Hodgson, Rydal Farm, Limousin steers 10-12 months old, achieved £1060 - £1070 and purchased by Andrew Hill, Doncaster.
