### **Prime Lambs**

A similar show to last week was forward with trade back on the previous week. Medium continental lambs averaged 147ppkg only 1ppkg back on the previous week.

Heavy lambs peaked at 140ppkg for a pen of Charolais X lambs 50kg making £74.

### **Cast Ewes**

A large show was forward this week with trade very similar to that of the previous week. Trade expected to improve as numbers begin to dry up during November.

### **Prime Cattle**

A larger than expected show was forward with trade noticeably better than that seen over previous week.

Top price went to a Lim X steer shown by P Bradley of Moor Green and sold for 216ppkg to S Mason & Sons Ltd.

### **Store Lambs**

A large show of over 2000 were forward with trade very similar to that seen last month.

Most lambs were achieving £46.53 with trade peaking at £67 per head for a pen of Beltex X lambs, shown by TA Waddington and bought by P Watson, Hellifield.

Mule lambs peaked at £58.50 for a pen of 52 sold by Messrs Hodgson of Rydal Hall and bought by J Proctor, Adgardley.
